HOLIDAY TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

The residential trash and recycling collection schedule will be impacted for the Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's holidays.

For Thanksgiving (Thursday, November 26), trash and recycling that would normally be collected on Thursday will be collected on Friday, November 27, and trash that would normally be collected on Friday will be collected on Saturday, November 28.

For Christmas Day (Friday, December 25), trash and recycling normally collected on Friday will be collected on Saturday, December 26. For New Year's Day (Friday, January 1), trash and recycling normally collected on Friday will be collected on Saturday, January 2.

Brush and bulk item collection are not impacted by the holiday schedule.

Follow These Tips to Dispose of Brush & Bulky Items

- Bulk items and brush are collected together all in one pile once per month and are limited to 10 cubic yards. Visit cedarhilltx.com/trash to find your collection schedule.
- Acceptable bulk items include appliances, furniture, fence sections, or other residential items too large for a container.
- Bulk items do NOT include construction debris, hazardous waste, vehicles, parts, or tires, televisions or computers, or items larger than 7 feet and heavier than 75 pounds.
- Bulk and green waste must be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on the Monday morning of your collection week. Waste Management may collect your items any day of the scheduled week.

THE FOUNTAINS AT LAKE RIDGE, CEDAR CREST HONORED WITH PREMIER NEIGHBORHOOD AWARD

The Fountains at Lake Ridge and Cedar Crest were recognized in October with the Premier Neighborhood Award. The Fountains at Lake Ridge, a small community of 63 homes, took the top honor based on their social activities during the pandemic. The neighborhood was especially proud of their “Night in White”, where families had socially-distanced mini-parties in their driveways with dancing and food while wearing white to show their community spirit.

Cedar Crest is home to more than 600 households along the wooded crest and creek tributaries between South Cedar Hill Road and Red Oak Creek. Cedar Crest recently became the fifth Public Improvement District in Cedar Hill, a result of hard work and many hours of outstanding neighborhood volunteers. During the pandemic, while limited on in-person events, Cedar Crest has kept residents informed through social media and organized a socially distanced clean-up.

The public input process for the new public library and signature park kicked off in October, with hundreds of participants sharing their thoughts and preferences on amenities and features of the project.

Library and Parks and Recreation staff hosted a myriad of opportunities of input throughout the month, included drive-thru events, a 'Community Fun Day', National Night Out, and Scare in the Park with t-shirts, treats and giveaways for participants.
