CEDAR HILL MAINTAINS LOWEST CRIME RATE IN BEST SOUTHWEST REGION

Chief Ely Reyes delivered the Cedar Hill Police Department's 2022 Annual Report this summer, reporting that Cedar Hill has experienced a 44% reduction in crimes between 2016 and 2022.

"Cedar Hill continues to have the lowest violent crime rate and the lowest property crime rate among the Best Southwest region," says Chief Reyes. "This is a direct reflection of the dedicated work our sworn and professional staff do to keep our community safe."

CATCH A RIDE WITH CEDAR HILL'S NEWEST PROVIDER: STAR TRANSIT

A new transportation option comes to Cedar Hill this summer as STAR Transit launches an on-demand bus service in Cedar Hill.

Two types of services will be offered in Cedar Hill - (1) a same day service for trips inside the Cedar Hill city limits and (2) an advanced schedule service to other destinations within the agency's service area and/or medical appointments.

STAR Transit offers discounted fares for seniors 60+, veterans, or people with disabilities. STAR Transit vehicles are ADA compliant and can handle most mobility devices. A client advocate service is also available at no additional cost for riders who may need assistance while traveling with STAR Transit for medical appointments. CEDAR HILL SPOTLIGHT: LESTER LORCH PARK

Lorch Park, located at 1823 Texas Plume Rd., offers visitors 82 acres of trees and meadows. In the spring and early summer, these meadows feature a colorful collection of wildflowers.

The park has several natural surface trails that weave in and out of the woods and through the meadows and a very popular disc golf course. A five-acre lake in the park is enjoyed by people who enjoy recreational fishing.

This site became the very first park in Dallas County's open space system when it was donated by the Lester Lorch family in 1976.
